Any individual in Michigan who has responsibility for Tuberculosis (TB) control and/or TB elimination in their agency. While the original network group was comprised of nurses at the local health department level, the network has opened the invitation to multidisciplinary members of the health care team.

1. To increase TB knowledge and clinical management
2. To increase understanding of MDCH and CDC guidelines
3. To provide TB case management support and discussion
4. To seek input and insight from Michigan TB nurses for training, quality assurance and quality improvement measures
5. To support and partner with local TB nurses, MDCH, and CDC to improve and sustain TB elimination efforts in Michigan
6. To provide nurse mentoring and advice when requested
